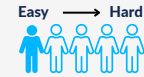


MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM CHECKLIST

CREATE YOUR PLANS

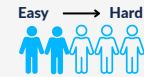


Creating your plans is the foundation for your membership program. Figure out all the benefits and discounts you will offer for your program. Next calculate your expense for each benefit then figure out what you will charge. Do a break even analysis.

ORGANIZE AGREEMENT



You will need to have an agreement between the practice and patient to keep on file. We provide an example agreement when you sign up for BoomCloud. make sure you figure out your terms, conditions and policies for your membership program.

SET UP YOUR SYSTEM

TRAIN YOUR STAFF

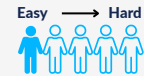

INTERNAL MARKETING

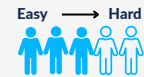

Exteral marketing will help your membership grow beyond your existing patient base. Direct mail, social media ads, google search ads, SEO, email marketing are all great ways to get the word out about your program.

INCENTIVIZE YOUR TEAM



Your team can make or break your membership program. Be sure to incentivize them by paying them small bonuses (eg: \$20 gift card) when patients sign up or rewarding the whole team with a fun staff party or vacation.
